To achieve a mirrored pattern, the order of the sequence must be reversed on tiles as required to achieve desired result. Refer to the Reflected Ceiling Plan.








Slide the two aluminum rails through all profiles using the slots provided. Remove labels.



Step 5

Turn assembly over and attach the acoustic mesh to the back of the tile using the pins provided. Note: Pins should be placed close to midpoints and corners.

Ceiling Grid Installation


Tile edge notch and tab profiles are designed to capture either \(^9\)/16"(15mm) or \(^15\)/16" (24mm) ceiling grid profiles. Tiles can be fitted and removed from ceiling grids quickly to access services above.






Reference numbers + letters 1, 3, B, E + H will be displayed on reverse face of the assembled profile, compared with other profiles.


Slide the two aluminium rails through the four longer profiles using the slots provided.

Attach the acoustic mesh to the back of the tile using the pins provided. Note: Pins should be placed close to midpoints and corners.



Step 2Push the 8 smaller profiles into the four longer profiles, in alternating sequence of the large and small profile shapes.




STEP 1

On a clean flat surface remove components from the protective surrounds. Ensure to group the similar items together. Identify which are the combs and profiles.




STEP 2

Insert a small profile into the combs at 45 degrees. Ensure a firm tight fit.



STEP 3


Insert the remaining small profiles into the combs shown, Leave insertion of the end profile until after the tile has been installed into the ceiling grid.




Complete the rest of the tile by inserting the large profiles into the assembly at a mirrored position to the smaller profiles already inserted into the combs.





STEP 5


Maneuver the tile above the ceiling grid and gently lower the tile until the profile tabs are resting on the grid.





Insert the remaining small profile in place.



Order of profile installation

ECOUSTIC SCULPT® CARE

Regular Care

- Protect from direct heat and sunlight
- To prevent dust build up, lightly dust with a soft cloth or vacuum with a soft brush attachment

Cleaning

- Professional cleaning is always recommended
- Always test any cleaning products on an inconspicuous area prior to commencing cleaning
- Blot any excess spills from the material with a dry clean sponge or cloth
- Treat all stains and spills as soon as possible
- Most marks can be spot cleaned by lightly wetting the affected area with a mild detergent and warm water solution
- Do not saturate the tile
- Do not scrub or abrade the surface as this will affect the surface finish
- Once the stain or mark has been loosened then blot the excess solution out with a dry clean sponge or cloth
- Sponge afterwards with clean warm water and dry any excess moisture with a dry clean sponge or cloth
- The product can also be spot cleaned with dry cleaning fluid, lightly sponge a small amount of dry cleaning fluid and blot
- Dry away from direct heat and sunlight
- Do not use carpet shampoo
